PLEASE NOTE

Exhibitors who require a VEHICLE PASS for use on Show Day at OLD RAILWAY LINE ENTRANCE ONLY MUST send their completed entry form to reach the appropriate Secretary by the stated closing dates, enclosing a STAMPED SELF ADDRESSED ENVELOPE. **Eligibility for one vehicle pass requires a minimum of three entries per household.**

10. Exhibits may be withdrawn at or after 5.30 p.m. No responsibility can be taken for items not removed by 6.00 p.m. The Society will not be held responsible for loss or damage to any items exhibited or left in the Marquee.
11. **Cups will be presented at 5.00 p.m. in the marquee.**
12. **Prize money to be collected in the marquee between 5.30 p.m. - 6.00 p.m. Any prize money not collected on Show day will be available for collection from the Show office before 30 August 2019. Uncollected prize money after this date will be treated as a donation to the Society.**
